

General terms and conditions

EN1. Participation

REcycle Club activities are reserved for organizations and active partners in the Real Estate sector, including architects, developers, financial organizations, agencies, contractors, experts, consultants, lawyers, public institutions as well as their partners. All participants must be at least 18 years old and register using the form provided.

EN2. Legal notice and disclaimer

- Participation requires good health. The organization recommends a preventive medical examination by a qualified sports doctor.

The organizer cannot be held responsible for any health problem of the participant.

- REcycle club is not responsible for damage, loss and/or theft of the participant's personal belongings before, during and after the event.

EN3. Cycling rules

- The participant accepts the uniqueness of this kind of event and has the will, despite the presence of the road captains, to take into account possible walkers or traffic.
- They respect the recommendations made by REcycle club and the code of conduct applied at all times.
- Cyclists will follow the road signs of the road captains.
- Before the start, participants will receive a quick briefing that will define the course of the outing. This is a group event. Therefore, the goal is to stay with the peloton. REcycle club declines all responsibility for cyclists wishing to do a solo ride.
- Cyclists must ride in a fair-play spirit and respect the local road regulations in force.
- Cyclists must wear the compulsory helmet.
- The organisers reserve the right to invite slower cyclists who are likely to slow down the peloton to board an assistance vehicle for recovery.
- Participants in REcycle Club activities will ensure that their sports and safety equipment has been recently checked by an experienced cycling mechanic and is suitable for the event.
- Bicycles with electric assistance, tandems, tricycles and unicycles are prohibited, except with special authorization from the organization.
- REcycle club reserves the right to change the course for safety or accessibility reasons.

EN4. Registration and cancellation policy

- Registration for a REcycle club activity will be completed after payment of the registration fee.
- If the event, in exceptional circumstances, cannot take place, the participant will not be able to claim a refund of the registration fee. The organiser cannot be obliged to refund the registration fee.
- In the event of non-participation, for whatever reason, no refund of the registration fee can be claimed. Transferring the registration fee to another person is strictly forbidden.
- If a participant cancels his/her registration between 2 months and 1 month of the event, 50% of the registration fee will be charged. If a registration is cancelled 1 month or less before the event, the total amount will be charged and will be due. Cancellation must be written to the organizers.
- Cancellation after this deadline will not be refunded.
- If the payment has not been made at the latest 8 days before the event, the registration is cancelled by right.

EN5. Publication rights for photos and films

By participating in a REcycle club activity, you commit yourself to the possible use of your information and image on paper, film, video, ... by the organizer.

This for promotional purposes. No fees can be claimed.

FR6. Data protection

Each participant agrees to share his or her medical data with medical professionals, if necessary/appropriate.

Each participant also agrees to follow any medical treatment recommended to him/her and authorizes notification to his/her relatives, if necessary/appropriate.

EN7. Environment
